The pride split up and the David spend most of his time alone. The decision was made to move Easy &amp; Shakira to Ricardo, They are in different bonding enclosures currently. It was suggested that we take 1 to 2 lions at a time to the clinic for much needed dentistry. On 7 August Old Chapel Clinic confirmed that both veterinary specialist would be available for dental surgery on 8 August. Simba &amp; Rey A were crated without sedation and transported to Pretoria. Dr Caldwell assisted Dr Stenekamp. Still awaiting formal reports. Both returned to Emoya on 8 August. They spend the nights in the crates and were observed hourly. The next morning they were released into their bonding enclosure and kept there for the time period they needed to be medicated: Clavumox 1g 2 tablets 2x/day for 6 days Tolfedine 60mg 2x 1x/day for 3 days Tramadol ½ tablet 2x/day for 3 days. Simba had no appetite on 9 &amp; 10 August. He was fed with tweezer until 17 August when he started eating strips by himself.
